Service Aide will follow well established work procedures, perform routine and repetitive assignments in a field setting. This incumbent may work without direct supervision. Good physical condition: ability to lift 20 lbs and move a minimum of 50 lbs. Must have a valid California Drivers License with a good driving record and be able to drive a manual transmission vehicle. Must be available to work weekdays, weekends and holidays. Approximately 20 to 32 hours per week.

Requirements:

Two years of experience in the care of non-domestic animal species preferred. Bachelor's degree in zoology, biology or related field preferred. Excellent public speaking and presentation skills. Flexible schedule; willing to work weekends, evenings, and holidays. Ability to work outside in all conditions, lift and carry in excess of 40lbs. Ability to stand, stoop, squat and walk for long periods of time.
